

Cardboard Boat Race

Rules & Regulations

1. Boats must be made of **cardboard only** (plus glue, tape, string and paint where appropriate - any paints used must be water-soluble).
2. You can't just wrap an actual kayak or canoe in cardboard!
3. Wrapping the boat in plastic or any other waterproofing is not allowed.
5. The addition of non-cardboard buoyancy features is not allowed
4. The boat must be designed to carry at least 1 person.
5. Prizes will be awarded for design, longest time afloat and longest distance paddled.
6. The decisions of the judges and scrutineers, however myopic, mistaken, biased or simply wrong will be final (unless everyone else disagrees...).
7. Anyone found to have cheated the above rules and not get caught will be praised by all (and then disqualified).
8. All competitors must remain safety conscious at all times and wear a BA whilst on the river.
